

Horance G. "Buddy" Davis, Jr. was an editorial writer for the Gainesville Sun and a professor of journalism at the University of Florida at Gainesville, he was awarded the Pulitzer Prize in 1971 for a series of editorials on school integration. Buddy Davis received his bachelors degree from the University of Florida, and in 1971 he was named a UF Distinguished Alumnus. In 1977 he received the highest service award from the Society of Professional Journalists, the Wells Memorial Key.

The Winners

The 10th grade first-place winning essay was written by Jaclyn Jacobs from GHS and whose teacher is Kathleen Solito. Jaclyn's essay is entitled "Indifference: An Ignored **Problem in Society." Maria Merolle, from Eastside High** School, authored the 10th grade second-place winning essay, "Change our Ways; Save Our Earth." Her teacher is Judith Boucias. The 11th grade first-place winning essay, "Virtual Addiction a Very Real Problem," was written by Robin Zhang Xu, a student at Buchholz High School and whose teacher is Patrick Gallagher. Kathryn Teclear, also a student from **Buchholz and in Patrick Gallagher's class, received the 11th** grade second-place award for her essay, "The Neglected Issue".

The Florida Free Speech Forum, based in Gainesville, is in its 18th year. The forum meets once a month and concentrates on topics related to freedom of speech and topics of compelling current interest. After the presentation, there is a question and answer session, both of which are recorded for rebroadcast on WUFT-FM. The luncheon buffet starts at 11:30 and the program starts at noon.

Luncheon: \$17 for members, \$18 for members who reserve late, and \$19 for non-members. The meals are paid for in advance; therefore, if you have made a reservation and then are unable to come, you are responsible for the luncheon unless you cancel by the Wednesday deadline.
